The hours are difficult as we study with others every day that we do not travel, and some that we do. We work hard to teach the Gospel to men and women who have never heard a single story about Jesus.

The trip to China is an investment in eternity. When we are about our Father's business we know that furthering His work takes an investment from us. The return this year was the baptism for forgiveness of sins of two ladies in Inner Mongolia. Eternity was changed. For such tremendous dividends the investment was paltry.
