WHOSE IS ON THE LORD'S SIDE?

Joshua saw the angel standing before him as he planned to go to Jericho. He asked, "Are you on our side or the side of our adversaries?" The angel answered, "No, I come as captain of the Lord of hosts." (Joshua 5:13-14 paraphrased) He wanted to know if he needed fear the angel or not. The angel's answer tells us a great deal. He was not on man's side but God's. If Joshua was on God's side they were allies, if he was not on God's side the angel would be his enemy.

Moses asks this question of the Israelites in Exodus 32:26. He asked for a response from those who were on the Lord's side. Israel had just worshipped the golden calf Aaron made for them while Moses was on Mt. Sinai receiving the 10 commandments from God. God was upset because His people deserted Him. Moses asked for commitment from Israel. "Who is on the Lord's side?"

The question rings through the ages and falls on our ears today. Whose side are you on? Will you be with those who worship the golden calf? You may not worship the golden calf but you may worship some other time robbing entity. Recall if you can why you missed services; am, pm, or class, over the last year. See if you want to take those reasons before God as an explanation for missing an opportunity to worship Him. Look how you treat others. Does your treatment of others represent the love He showed to you? Do you want to have to answer for the way you treated someone else? Not just the good ones remember the times you treated someone else badly. Ask yourself now, "Whose side am I on?" Time is coming when you will want to know the answer to that question because you will be asked.
