YOU KNOW WHERE YOU WERE

Everyone who was old enough to remember the attacks of 9/11/2001 remembers where they were when the first plane hit the towers. I was on my way to Columbus, OH to take a welding test for a new job. I noticed an eerie silence on the city and learned about the attacks when I arrived and listened to the radio. It was surreal to think we were under attack and wonder what was next. We still remember the events, especially the first responders, police, firefighters, and EMTs as they rushed up the doomed buildings not knowing it would be their last actions ever. We honor their courage and sacrifice and we remember the lives they saved as they offered their own.

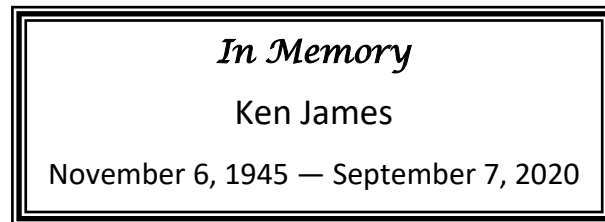
