CAN THE LORD'S SUPPER EVER BE TOO COMMON?

The frequency of the Lord's Supper has come under question at times and it is appropriate to reconsider such studies to ensure we are acting as God would have us to act. What events surrounded the institution of the Lord's Supper? Taking all of the accounts into consideration (Matthew 26:16-35, Mark 14:22-31, and Luke 22:14-23) we find that the bread was likely unleavened used at the Passover. The fruit of the vine was grape juice that was probably unfermented. Jesus gives no reference as to when this is to take place. His institution was Thursday night. He never says when it is to be done as recorded in the text. Paul said that Jesus' instructions were that we do this in His remembrance (I Corinthians 11:24-25).

So how do we know to do this act on the first day of the week? Acts 20:7, "On the first day of the week, WHEN we were gathered together TO BREAK BREAD..." (Emphasis mine). The church at Troas, along with the apostles, came together on the first day of the week, as a normal practice, to partake of the Lord's Supper. This was the reason for the gathering. Paul addressed this issue with his correction of the Corinthian Christians in chapter 11. He tells them in Verse 20 of I Corinthians that they are not meeting to observe the Lord's Supper because what they are doing is not the Lord's Supper. He continues on to correct their mistakes in this regard. When they came together it was to commemorate the Lord's death with the observance of the Lord's Supper, not to fill their own bellies. Paul told them the lesson we need to know.

The first day of the week is the Lord's Day and He is to be honored in special ways as prescribed by Him on that day. We are to gather around His table and commemorate His death every week as the example set for us by inspired men in the first-century.
