Barabbas was a bad man. He was an insurrectionist who committed murder during the insurrection. What does that mean? He led a revolt against Rome and in the process most likely killed a Roman soldier or ranking official. This would be high treason and the only punishment was death; the most horrific death known to man, crucifixion. Barabbas was destined to hang on a cross.

The Romans liked to make a spectacle of crucifixions so they would have the maximum effect in deterring future offenses. They picked the weekend of the Passover for an important crucifixion such as that of Barabbas so that as large a number of Jews as possible would see what happens to those who rebel against Rome. Barabbas' death was to have a large crowd of spectators.

He was waiting for the clunk of the key and the groan of the heavy cell door as it opened for the soldiers to lead him to his scourging and cross. When he heard the soldiers he was likely prepared for the worst. The door opened and the soldiers said, "Barabbas, you are free to go. Pilate has released you and someone else will die on your cross. Some guy called Jesus from Nazareth." What a relief for Barabbas. He was free because Jesus was on his cross.

Is it any different for me? My insurrections against the Lord murdered Him on the cross. It should have been mine but instead He took it. I am Barabbas, set free because Jesus died in my place.

"But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed" Isaiah 53:5
