A HEART ATTACK

Our hearts get attacked from many sides in life. We see examples of this throughout the Bible as men who did godly things struggled with attacks from Satan trying to weaken their hearts. These men, some overcame the attacks and some did not, represent the struggles we have even today. Our attacks may come in different forms but are really all the same, an appeal to our vanity or physical pleasures. In the end we must all learn to survive the heart attacks.

Consider David, a man after God's own heart. His heart was attacked by lust when he saw Bathsheba bathing. While her husband was away defending the kingdom entrusted by God to David he was busy with her. He gave in to the attack, had an affair with Bathsheba and ultimately killed Uriah because he lost that battle with the devil. He was able to overcome this failure through repentance but this time he lost a significant battle.

Peter was a man who struggled mightily. His inclination was to do right. Too often his inclination rushed past his intellect. He moved forward on what he thought was going to be right and it was actually not what Jesus intended. His struggles led him to a young girl who tended a gate.
