A MIRACLE PEOPLE NOTICED

Acts 3:1-10

Many make claims to miracles, most happen with little to no notice by those not directly related to the alleged miracle. This leaves some question in the minds of those who were not present whether or not a miracle actually happened.

Notice at least one miracle that happened and had everyone talking. A man who was lame from birth was lying in the Beautiful Gate of the temple when Peter and John walked by. He asked them for money which they did not have. Instead Peter gave him a better gift; he healed him so he could walk. He began walking and leaping and going about praising God. Acts 3:9 says "all the people saw him walking" and that they all recognized him as the beggar from the Beautiful Gate. Everyone who saw the man knew who he was and that it was a miracle that he was walking.

If you go on and read the rest of the story you will find some important details. First, Peter claimed no responsibility for the miracle but gave God all the credit. Second, it accomplished its goal because many who saw the miracle believed in Jesus. Third, those involved, Peter and John, were persecuted because of their faith in God. When we allow God to use us and give Him glory two things will happen. The world of unbelievers will push back against the good God does regardless of His chosen vessel, even if it's you. And God's work will always lead to faith, whether it's a new faith in unbelievers or a stronger faith in those who believe.
