WHAT'S YOUR MOTIVATION?

Matthew 6:1-4

A woman heard a knock at the door. She answered to find a man asking for help for an unfortunate family. He said, "The husband lost his job, the utilities are about to be shut off, and they are about to be kicked out of their apartment." The lady said that she would love to help and asked, "By the way, who are you?" He replied, "I'm their landlord."

We must wonder about his motivations when he is willing to solicit money from the neighborhood for money for his own tenants to pay him rent. Do our motives matter when we do good things? Jesus teaches us in Matthew 6:1-4 that motives matter. When you give to be seen you have your full reward when people see you. Giving is not to be a spectacle that draws attention to you. It is to be private, helpful to the recipient, and draw attention to God. The only reason we exist must be to glorify God and our "alms giving" must be with Him in mind.

Whatever you do, motives matter. The right thing for the wrong reason is the wrong thing. The wrong thing for the right reason is the wrong thing. Only when we do the right things for the right reasons is God happy with our sacrifice and willing to claim us as His own. So I ask you today to consider one question before you do anything, "What is my motivation?"
