No passage of Scripture brings it to light like James 3. "And the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity. The tongue is so set among our members that it defiles the whole body, and sets on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire by hell...But no man can tame the tongue. It is an unruly evil, full of deadly poison. With it we bless our God and Father, and with it we curse men, who have been made in the similitude of God. Out of the same mouth proceed blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not to be so" (James 3:6,8-10).

As children we heard the old adage, "Sticks and stones will break my bones, but names will never hurt me." Sticks and stones can indeed cause significant harm to the human body, but to suggest that words cannot hurt is ridiculous. People can be driven to tears, homes can be torn apart, lives can be ruined, etc., all from malicious words.

Perhaps we would use greater caution in what we say if we would remember the Golden Rule. "Therefore, whatever you want men to do to you, do also to them, for this is the Law and the Prophets" (Matt. 7:12). If you don't want others to speak evil of you, or to say things that are hurtful, then you should be careful in the things that you say.

Jesus warned, "A good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings forth good things, and an evil man out of the evil treasure brings forth evil things. But I say to you that for every idle word men may speak, they will give account of it in the day of judgment. For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned" (Matt. 12:35-37).

Since the tongue is such a powerful thing, watch what you say!

Becky Kidder is recovering from knee replacement surgery. She began physical therapy last week.


Kirk Malone is doing well since his hip replacement. He wants to thank everyone for the calls, cards, and prayers.
