Speaking In Tongues

Among the spiritual gifts found in the early church was that of speaking in tongues (1 Cor. 12:10). The word "tongues" is a metonymy, a figure of speech where one word stands for another. In this case, "tongues" refer to languages. This is evident by the use of the term in Acts 2. We learn in Acts 2:4 that the Holy Spirit enabled the apostles to speak "with other tongues." "Tongues" is then explained in vs 6: "And when this sound occurred, the multitude came together, and were confused, because everyone heard them speak in his own language." "Tongues" as it is used in Acts 2, clearly has reference to languages.

What then has caused the confusion we see in the religious world today? It was brought on by mistranslation. The King James Version in 1 Cor. 14, modifies the word "tongue" six times with the word "unknown". The Greek word is glossa, a word which simply means "tongue." Bear in mind that the tongue is unknown only in the sense that it is unknown to those who speak a different language. For example, Spanish is a language that may not be known to you. So, in that sense, it is an unknown tongue.

The other problem that has surfaced has come from the New English Bible which translates *glossa* as "a language of ecstasy." If you look up ecstasy you will find it means, "a state of being beyond reason and self-control, a state of overwhelming emotion; especially: rapturous delight." Those who claim to speak in tongues today actually speak in meaningless gibberish. It stems from great emotion (and apparently great imagination).
