Troubled Youth

"Our youth now love luxury. They have bad manners, contempt for authority; they show disrespect for their elders and love chatter in place of exercise; they no longer rise when elders enter the room; they contradict their parents, chatter before company; gobble up their food and tyrannize their teachers." (Socrates, 5th Century BC)

What is fun is to take the above quote and let people read it without revealing its author or when it was written. You then ask them, "When do you think those words was written?" Invariably you will find the vast majority to be shocked to learn the truth.

In honesty it does sound like something that could have been written in our own day. Young people do love luxury. Their love for money and things is as strong as ever. They exhibit contempt for modern authority often showing disrespect for parents, teachers, law enforcement, etc. Many have absolutely no interest in exercise. They would rather watch movies, play video games, spend time on their computers, or have fun on their cell phones. They openly contradict their parents, sometimes in front of company and go undisciplined for it. They expect to be fed and treated like royalty and yet continue to show disrespect and rudeness towards teachers.

What this article does is to remind us that man himself changes very little. Some 2600+ years have passed since Socrates lamented what he saw in the children of his day. Can we honestly say that children have changed in these areas?

It is difficult for parents to raise their children in the right way today (cf. Prov. 22:6; Eph. 6:1-4). But don't kid yourself. It was difficult even a hundred years ago. Granted the times and conditions were different, but youth were still considered difficult. It will always be a challenge to raise them properly.
