Tickle My Ears

Centuries ago, the prophet Isaiah spoke of the children of God and their troubling attitude: "Who say to the seers, "Do not see," And to the prophets, "Do not prophesy to us right things; Speak to us smooth things, prophesy deceits" (Isa 30:10).

In the New Testament, in the apostle Paul's writings to the young preacher Timothy comes a similar admonition: "Preach the word! Be ready in season and out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching. For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers; and they will turn their ears away from the truth and be turned aside to fables" (2 Tim 4:2-4).

It is troubling today to listen to people who want to hear something other than the truth. They discourage preachers from preaching the Word. Instead, they ask for things they want to hear rather than what needs to be preached.

Our goal is not to be man pleasers (Gal. 1:10). Remember that our Lord indicted those who live for the praise of men: "Woe to you when all men speak well of you, for so did their fathers to the false prophets" (Luke 6:26).

The Lord is pleased with those people who are willing to hear the truth and obey it. Such individuals are more interested in pleasing God. And they know that hearing the truth at times can be difficult and challenging, but they reverence and respect God and know that they are not living for themselves, but for the Lord.

May we always ask for the truth and not cry for words that tickle the ears.
