Nothing Without Love

"Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I have become sounding brass or a clanging cymbal. And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing. And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, but have not love, it profits me nothing" (1 Cor. 13:1-3).

Christianity is hollow without love. Despite all that we say and do, if we don't have love, it is all for show.

The Scribes and Pharisees were proficient at appearing to be men of righteousness, but the Lord exposed their hypocrisy (Matt. 6). Consider, if we lack love, in what way are we better than them?

Jesus said to His disciples, "A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another" (John 13:34-35).

The Lord emphasized that love for Him and for one another is a must. That was stressed even during the Mosaic Law. "Jesus said to him, 'You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.' This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets'" (Matt. 22:37-40).

Churches grow and die based upon love, or the lack of it. If we truly love the Lord and the souls of the lost, we will reach out and bring them to Jesus. But if our Christianity is hollow, and we only go through the motions, eventually the local church can and will die. Ephesus is a prime example of what happens when the love is gone (Rev. 2:1-6).

If you want to see God's children be more loving, then take the initiative. Let your love be known for others, and you will find it to be contagious.
