Godly Balance By Jesse Eaton

In life today, achieving true balance can be one of the greatest challenges. Americans, as a whole, are busier now than they have ever been before, constantly rushing from activity to activity, place to place, always to be found frantically pursuing the latest trend or fad... you get the idea. Not only is life busier now than it ever has been, but our beliefs and views are more polarized than they have ever been. Politics drive a wedge deep into communities, families, and even homes. We tend to fall into the thinking that either things are red or blue, and that there is no middle ground. How does this thinking affect our spiritual lives? Always seeking the next thing to be rushing on to? Always towing the party line?

These "ideals" stand in stark contrast to what the LORD calls His people to. One of my favorite passages in the Bible has long been Psalm 46:10, with its recognition of who God is, "... our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble..." (v1), but also the reality check which it issues, to "Be still and know that I am God" (v10a). God calls us to know who He is and with that knowledge to be still and to allow Him to work out his purposes. We often find ourselves swept up in the busy pace of life, but God calls us away from this flurry of activity to be still and to remind ourselves of who our God is.

A more pressing issue, however, is the encroachment of political polarization into the church. We must remember that our identity is not found in one party or the other. Our citizenship is found in heaven (Phil. 3:20), and that we abide by God's moral standards, not by what one party or another declares is right or true (Acts 5:29).

A truly balanced life, then, resembles the following: We must build our lives upon God and Christ, the "precious cornerstone and sure foundation" (Isaiah 28:16). We must understand who we are in light of who God is. And finally, we must do what He says, not swaying to the left or to the right, but above all fearing God and keeping His commands (Eccl. 12:13,14). May we all strive to stand apart from the world that is out of balance, and strive to seek justice, love mercy, and walk humbly with our God (Micah 6:8).
