Throughout the history of mankind, God has selected special people to lead and protect His people... from Moses and Joshua to the prophets, and later the kings such as David and Solomon, God has always had a powerful hand in the human guidance of His chosen people. It is essential that the right men are selected for the position of elder by the congregation: a man who is able and willing to teach, a man who is concerned about the future of the congregation, a man with a heart for evangelism, and above all, a man who is gualified and is willing to serve as elder.

May we all pray that God will establish the leadership that He sees best for our congregation, and may we pray continually for our elders as they face one of the most difficult roles in the Lord's Church today.

Pam Kupfner was admitted to the hospital on Thursday with Colitis. She is at Camden Clark Medical Center. Room #507A.


Buster Kupfner will have surgery on Thursday, June 22nd, to repair a hiatal hernia.
