God's Qualifications for Elders

The role of an Overseer, or Shepherd, is the most important position of leadership and authority in each congregation of the Lord's Church. How fitting, then, is it that God has taken time and detail to describe what He requires of men who would seek to become an elder.

Of utmost importance is the reputation of an overseer. Paul instructs Timothy that an overseer "must be above reproach... sober-minded, self-controlled, respectable, hospitable... not a drunkard, not violent but gentle, not quarrelsome, not a lover of money" (1 Timothy 3:2,3). The character of a man who desires to become an overseer is paramount to his position - if he expects to shepherd the 'sheep' by his example, he must live a righteous life. Because elders should also be those who are at the forefront of the congregation's outreach into the community, others outside the body need to see their good character. If an elder would be a violent, quarrelsome man or one who is not self-controlled in any way, this would not only give the Church a bad name, but also the Lord. Paul exhorts Timothy that an overseer "... must be well thought of by outsiders, so that he may not fall into disgrace, into the condemnation of the devil" (1 Timothy 3:7).

Along with having a sound character, those seeking to become Shepherds are called to "be able to teach" (2 Timothy 3:2). As we noted last week, the two main jobs elders are called to fulfill is leading the flock (protection) and feeding the flock (teaching). If a man has not and is not comfortable teaching the congregation, or lacks the knowledge to be able to instruct the congregation in God's Word, he is most certainly unqualified to become an overseer. This inexperience is also shown as Paul states that "He must not be a recent convert, or he may become puffed up with conceit and fall into the condemnation of the devil" (1 Timothy 3:6).

Lastly, Paul says that an elder must be "the husband of one wife," and that he must "manage his own household well with all dignity, keeping his children submissive" (1 Timothy 3:2,4). The idea of a husband of one wife conveys the same concept as Paul has discussed previously, as he says that husbands are to love their wives as Christ loved the church and gave Himself for her (Ephesians 5:25). As with both of these qualifications that Paul commands, he gives reasoning in verse 5: "... for if someone does not know how to manage his own household, how will he care for God's church?" Paul goes further in the Epistle to Titus, even stating that "... his children must be believers and not open to the charge of debauchery or insubordination."

As members of the Lord's body, we must recognize that we have the opportunity to select the men who would become Shepherds to guide us and to teach us. We must make certain that these men meet every qualification provided by God, otherwise they should not be selected. Appointing Overseers is a serious business, and should not be taken quickly or light-
