A Lot Of "Ifs"

by Mark Aites

In 1 John 1:6-10, the apostle John uses the word "if" five times:

"If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth" (1 John 1:6).

"But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin" (1 John 1:7).

"If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us" (1 John 1:8).

"If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1 John 1:9).

"If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us" (1 John 1:10).

Webster states that the word "if" means, "in the event that b: allowing that c: on the assumption that d: on condition that"; and is described as a word of function. That being the case, it denotes action.

John stresses action as we can profess to have fellowship, but do we practice the truth? We can profess to walk in the light, but do we put it into practice? We can profess that we have no sin, but do our actions betray us? We can profess that we have made peace with God, but do our actions demonstrate that we have failed to confess our sins? Again, we can claim that we have not sinned, but do our actions reveal the truth and make us liars?

The book of 1 John is a book that emphasizes the importance of more action and less talk. The early Christians had many weaknesses that needed attention. John sought to motivate them to do more than just talk about their love for God. They needed to manifest it in their daily lives, as do we.
