Is It Ever Right To Tell A Lie?

“Therefore, putting away lying, ‘Let each one of you speak truth with his neighbor,’ for we are members of one another” (Eph 4:25). “Do not lie to one another, since you have put off the old man with his deeds” (Col 3:9).

One of the common beliefs of our time is that in certain situations, it is acceptable to lie. For example, in situations which are life threatening, it is okay to lie to save one's life. This reasoning is commonly referred to as situation ethics.

Situation Ethics is the belief that in certain situations “moral principles can be cast aside if love is best served.” Joseph Fletcher who is credited for this line of reasoning, stated, “Love is the ultimate law.” Fletcher believed that laws could be broken “if the other course of action would result in more love.”

Out of this concept came the notion that “the end justifies the means.” In effect, it is not the actions one takes to get such results that matters, but simply the end result. If one has to lie to get a good result, so be it. If one has to steal, cheat, and break other laws that is okay, as long as the end goal is achieved.

What we are noting here is human reasoning. God does not think like we do. “‘For My thoughts are not your thoughts, Nor are your ways My ways,’ says the Lord. ‘For as the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways, and My thoughts than your thoughts’” (Isa. 55:8-9). “Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men, and the weakness of God is stronger than men” (1 Cor. 1:25).

Is it ever right to lie? The answer is a resounding, NO! Early Christians died because they refused to lie. They refused to deny Jesus as the Christ. Liars will have their part in the lake that burns with fire and brimstone (Rev. 21:8).
