The Remission of Sins

The phrase, "remission of sins" is found some 9 times in the New Testament. The word "remission" is not a word that we tend to use in everyday language. It refers to "release from bondage or imprisonment; forgiveness or pardon of sins (letting them go as if they had never been committed), remission of the penalty." (Enhanced Strong's Lexicon). In our modern vernacular we refer to it as the forgiveness of sins.

The Bible makes it crystal clear that sin will not inherit heaven. "But there shall by no means enter it anything that defiles, or causes an abomination or a lie, but only those who are written in the Lamb's Book of Life" (Rev. 21:27). The remission or forgiveness of our sins is vital if we are to enjoy an eternity in the presence of Almighty God.

Realizing the importance of having our sins remitted, we need to be sure that we do exactly as the Bible teaches to make that a reality. On the day of Pentecost, by divine authority, the apostle Peter told those Jews who were guilty of the death of Christ, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit" (Acts 2:38). In order then to have the remission of sins, one must be baptized for that purpose!

Many people today speak of being baptized and speak of it as an act of obedience. While it is an act of obedience, Peter makes it abundantly clear that there is a purpose in being baptized, in order that one can have the remission of his sins.

When the apostle Paul was saved, the Bible records Ananias telling him, "And now why are you waiting? Arise and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord" (Acts 22:16). The remission or washing away of his sins was achieved in his baptism.

If one is not baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission or forgiveness of his sins, he is not saved.
