The Forgotten Text

"Moreover if your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone. If he hears you, you have gained your brother. But if he will not hear, take with you one or two more, that 'by the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established.' And if he refuses to hear them, tell it to the church. But if he refuses even to hear the church, let him be to you like a heathen and a tax collector" (Matt 18:15-17).

The text of Matt. 18:15-17 is often forgotten when it comes to practical application. If someone has wronged us, we handle it differently than outlined by our Lord.

First, we illicit the telephone, or perhaps email, or talking with others in person. We speak of the one who has wronged us and it seems that we want the sympathy of others to make our grievance justified in our minds.

Second, we might go straight to an elder or preacher, hoping to illicit their aid. If we can get one of them on "our side," then perhaps we feel we are justified in our actions and words.

In reality, both of these approaches are not Scriptural. Jesus tells us if someone wrongs us, "go and tell him his fault between you and him alone." Think of how many problems could be avoided if we would heed that simple admonition.

Granted, there may come a time that you need to bring the situation to the attention of others, not for the purpose of gossip, but to settle the matter. Jesus even tells us that if our efforts fail that ultimately the problem can be taken before the church. The point we need to see is that God has outlined for us a way to handle our personal problems and misunderstandings.

If you do have a problem with your brother or sister, by all means take care of it right away. Jesus says that is to be done before proceeding with your sacrifices to God (Matt. 5:23-24).
