On April 12, 2023, the number of visitors to the World War II Memorial increased to approximately 4.82 million in 2022. Visitors to the Franklin Delano Roosevelt Memorial in 2018 far exceeded 3 million. Since the establishment of the 9/11 memorial, more than 43 million people have visited the site. It is estimated that 6 million people go to the Lincoln Memorial each year. Almost 3 million visited the Thomas Jefferson Memorial in 2022. The USS Arizona sees almost 2 million visitors annually. It does seem as if Americans take their memorials seriously, and rightly so. We indeed honor those who gave their lives for this great nation.

Memorials are also an important part of Scripture. "Then Joshua called the twelve men whom he had appointed from the children of Israel, one man from every tribe; and Joshua said to them: "Cross over before the ark of the Lord your God into the midst of the Jordan, and each one of you take up a stone on his shoulder, according to the number of the tribes of the children of Israel, that this may be a sign among you when your children ask in time to come, saying, 'What do these stones mean to you?' Then you shall answer them that the waters of the Jordan were cut off before the ark of the covenant of the Lord; when it crossed over the Jordan, the waters of the Jordan were cut off. And these stones shall be for a memorial to the children of Israel forever" (Josh 4:4-7).

Of course, the greatest memorial is in memory of Jesus Christ, who gave His life for our sins. "For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord Jesus on the same night in which He was betrayed took bread; and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me." In the same manner He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me" (1 Cor. 11:23-25).
