This old illustration is precious because it presents an all too familiar truth. No one wants to take the initiative or responsibility to do something that needs to be done. Instead, they hold back and wait for someone else to do it. And if it does not get done, or is not done properly, they complain.

A common phrase that is overheard in the church today is, "When are they going to do something about it?" Of course, the natural question is, who is being referred to by using the pronoun they?

The Lord charges us to seek and save the lost in the Great Commission (Matt. 28:19-20; Mark 16:15). Someone says, "When are they going to do something about seeking lost souls?" (Likely referencing the preacher and elders) It probably doesn't occur to them, the more needful question is, "When am I going to do something about it?"

It may well be that there is a problem with the building and grounds. Again, that all too familiar question, "When are they going to do something about it?" Isn't it ironic that they see a need and instead complain? Why not instead ask, "Is there something I can do to help fix the problem?"

The church today is plagued with those waiting for someone to do something. Why not instead, seeing a need, ask yourself, "What can I do to help?" And then, do it!
