Your brain weighs about three pounds and yet contains more than a hundred billion neurons. In your brain there are more than ten billion nerve cells which are more advanced and complex than most modern computer systems. According to the Piedmont website, "there are 100,000 miles of blood vessels in the brain. The distance around the world at the equator is 24,900 miles." So yes, you indeed are wonderfully made (Psa. 139:14). And contrary to what you may have heard, the knowledge you can store in that wonderful brain is virtually endless.

You actually use only a small portion of your thinking equipment. Most of us use less than one-tenth of our brain's capacity. If you were able to force your brain to work at only one-half its capacity, you could attain and maintain fluency in over forty languages, memorize the entire encyclopedia from cover to cover, and complete the required courses of many dozens of colleges. Yes, few of us use the brain that God gave us. Thomas Edison once remarked that only five percent of the population thinks. He said that ten percent think they think, and the other eighty-five percent would rather die than think.

Are you fearful of overextending yourself? Are you afraid of over-using your brain? Listen to the wisdom of Arnold Bennet: "One of the chief things which my typical man has to learn is that the mental faculties are capable of continuous hard activity; they do not tire like an arm or leg. All they want is change - not rest, except in sleep." The psalmist speaks of meditating upon the word of God "day and night" (Psa. 1:2).

There is no shortcut to Bible knowledge; comprehension is a fruit of repetition.

David claimed to have hidden the word of God in his heart (Psa. 119:11). According to the apostle Paul, Timothy knew the holy scriptures from his childhood (2 Tim. 3:14,15). We, too, can know the Bible and hide it in our hearts; but this knowledge comes from diligent daily study. And guess what, your brain can handle it!
