Nothing In A Name

No doubt you have heard the age-old question, "Is there anything in a name?" While so many would so easily dismiss the importance of a name, they fail to realize just how important a name really is.

You may have heard the old story, that is often used, of a preacher continuing to say in the pulpit, over and over, "There is nothing in a name." The elderly woman listening wrote a sizeable check to that preacher's delight as a significant contribution, but then he realized she failed to sign it. When confronted came her curt reply, "I thought you said there is nothing in a name?"

Proper names have great significance and we use them all the time. The name on your driver's license matters. The name signed to your tax return matters. The name affixed to your paycheck matters.

It is ironic that people would insist on their usage on checks or forms, but then seek to belittle the use of names in God's Word. For example, if you say to them that names used for the church must have a Scriptural origin, they poke fun at that idea. What we use must come from the Bible. "Churches of Christ" (Rom. 16:16), the "church of God" (1 Cor. 1:2), "church of the firstborn" (Heb. 12:23), etc.

"And the disciples were first called Christians in Antioch" (Acts 11:26). If there is nothing in a name, why not change the name *Christian* to *idiot*? Do people who think there is nothing in a name like the idea of being called "idiots"? Of course not! Worldly minded people may do it to Christians, but godly people would never tolerate it because they know it is wrong.

It has been well said, "We speak where the Bible speaks, we are silent where the Bible is silent, we call Bible things by Bible names, and we do Bible things in Bible ways."

Names have value and they are given to be honored and respected. Man does not have the right to change what God has divinely given.
