Beware of Extremes

"Extremes are dangerous." - Jonathan Mayhew

Centuries ago, Scripture gave a clear warning to the children of Israel, "Therefore you shall be careful to do as the Lord your God has commanded you; you shall not turn aside to the right hand or to the left" (Deut. 5:32; cf. 17:11,20). In facing religious ideas and concepts it is important that we be cautious that we don't listen to those who go to extremes; i.e. binding where God has not bound and loosing where God has not loosed. For example, some prohibiting the use of a pitch pipe while others would bring in an organ or piano. Webster defines such as "going to great or exaggerated lengths," "situated at the farthest

We are on a strait path that leads to life; one that is narrow and constrictive (Matt. 7:13 -14). But what remains unseen are the ditches on either side of this path. And yes, there are ditches to the left and to the right. And in those ditches we find the ugliness of intolerance. There are some who apparently think that God has granted them extreme positions. Our Lord told Peter, "And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven" (Matt. 16:19). So man assumes he can bind his edicts upon men, or he can loose the very commands of God.

It is sad to see brethren given to such extremes, and yet invoking the name of God. Many no doubt are familiar with the concept of the pendulum. In effect, it is a weight that hangs from a pivot that allows it to swing in either direction. As it relates to views that brethren hold on religious subjects, guite often they may be prone to swing the pendulum in one direction. But perhaps later, choose to swing it to the opposite extreme.
