Doubt
by Mark Aites

“Doubt makes the mountain which faith can move.” – Anonymous, from the Toledo (Ohio) Blade, Jan. 1931

If you have ever doubted the existence of God, then you are normal. It happens to the best of folks. But the concern arises when we are not satisfied with the evidence presented to us.

Most folks have the notion that faith is baseless and without reason or evidence. But that actually is not true. “The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament shows His handiwork” (Psa. 19:1). “Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen” (Heb. 11:1). Notice that both passages speak of evidence. But if people doubt and choose to ignore what God has provided, He will not be pleased. “For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse” (Rom. 1:20).

Perhaps what causes us the most distress are the books and TV programs that would suggest that there is not a God. These programs explain away what is clearly printed in the sacred text. And it does not help when they have someone interviewed who has a degree, or degrees, that pertain to religion, that cast doubt on what the Bible says.

There is a grave concern that this doubt and uncertainty is causing Christians to be more quiet about their faith. They begin to wonder if there really is a God.

And what about the most seasoned veterans of the cross when they have doubts? Yes, it is part of being human. Perhaps we can refer to it as the Elijah syndrome (1 Kings 18-19), or John the Baptist syndrome (Matt. 11:2-3). There will likely come a time that you will struggle, but take heart, the evidence abounds enough to revive your faith!

Here is the text: “For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and God-head, so that they are without excuse”

- 1. **Who?** God. The eternal, existent One. The only one, true God.
- 2. **What?** Witnessing and knowing about God’s existence and His true nature and power. The evidence and proof is more than abundant.
- 3. **When?** Since the very beginning – throughout all of time. There has never been a time when people could not know that there is a God.
- 4. **Where?** Literally everywhere the creation can be seen. It is evident and can be clearly observed and deciphered by all.
- 5. **Why?** So that we may believe. If we examine all of this evidence and do not believe, then we are without excuse.
