Gospel Meeting

We warmly welcome you to our Gospel Meeting. Keeping with Scripture, we "greet you" (Rom. 16:16).

You may have a curiosity as to what we mean by a "Gospel Meeting." That is certainly not a familiar expression save in churches of Christ. Often times you may hear the expression, "A Revival." It is an opportunity to have a series of lessons in which the Gospel message is preached perhaps to those who are hearing it for the first time.

The apostle Paul certainly knew of the importance of the Gospel. "For if I preach the gospel, I have nothing to boast of, for necessity is laid upon me; yes, woe is me if I do not preach the gospel" (1 Cor. 9:16)! "For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek. For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, 'The just shall live by faith'" (Rom. 1:16-17).

Let's break it down even more. Just what is the Gospel? It is the good news. And what is the good news? "For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures" (1 Cor. 15:3-4).

We share in that message in hopes that precious souls can be saved from their sins. Jesus said, "I say to you that likewise there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents..." (Luke 15:7).
