"He who has not tasted bitter does not know what sweet is." – German Proverb

"And Laban said to him, 'Please stay, if I have found favor in your eyes, for I have learned by experience that the Lord has blessed me for your sake'" (Gen. 30:27). Experience can be quite a teacher, as Laban learned being near Jacob.

No matter what we face in life, through experience we learn a great deal. Many people are "book smart," but to them much of it is simply theory. Until they are in the trenches, what they have learned in books will not be fully realized.

When in school, learning about the preacher and his work was a fascinating study. But living it firsthand is not quite what one expected. There is no way to adequately express the joy of immersing a lost soul into Christ. You are an instrument of God's will that gives you an experience that is hard to put into words. One can read of occasions such as the conversion of the Ethiopian in Acts 8, and surmise that Philip must have felt blessed to have been an instrument of doing God's will. But to have had firsthand experience, is a joy that is so profound. Be thankful for your experiences. It has helped make you the person that you are!
