Setting Goals

It certainly is a prudent move to set goals. It is far better to have some-
thing to aim for than to wander aimlessly throughout life. A lack of goals
can actually lead one to a life of laziness. In such a case, there is no desire
to be industrious. The wise man says, "Go to the ant, you sluggard! Con-
sider her ways and be wise" (Prov. 6:6).

The Bible warns us, however, in making plans or setting goals to be
cautious that we do not leave God out of our plans. "Come now, you who
say, 'Today or tomorrow we will go to such and such a city, spend a year
there, buy and sell, and make a profit'; whereas you do not know what will
happen tomorrow. For what is your life? It is even a vapor that appears for
a little time and then vanishes away. Instead you ought to say, 'If the Lord
wills, we shall live and do this or that.' But now you boast in your arro-
gance. All such boasting is evil" (James 4:13-16).

What James writes is a reminder to all of us of the brevity of life. Yes,
making goals is a wise move. Because time is short, we need to have a bet-
ter handle on the time we have. If one is not careful, years can pass with-
out any meaningful accomplishment.

In modern times you will hear folks speak of their personal, "Bucket
List". Often these are unusual goals that one hopes to reach before they
die. One wishes they would have the same zeal and interest in preparing
themselves for eternity. Long ago God's children heard that cry. "Therefore
thus will I do to you, O Israel; because I will do this to you, prepare to meet
your God, O Israel" (Amos 4:12).
