"The Wicked Bible"

According to the website of "Proof Read Anywhere.com," there was a gave disaster that happened hundreds of years ago. "In 1631, two London printers made one mistake. They were typesetting a new edition of the King James Bible, working by Candlelight, and somewhere in the Ten Commandments, they left a single word out. The commandment was supposed to read, 'Thou shalt not commit adultery.' What the printed was, 'Thou shalt commit adultery.'"

The article continues, "The book became known as the Wicked Bible. The printers were fined the equivalent of a year's wages and lost their printing licenses entirely.
