## GOD'S GUIDANCE

Dr. Ignaz Semmelweiss in his book, None of These Diseases, in 1840, discusses his experience at an Austrian hospital. He required examiners to wash their hands after performing an autopsy on a disease victim. Mortality rates dropped drastically. When he instituted the washing of hands between each patient examination, death rates dropped even lower. Other doctors resented the inconvenience of continually washing and forced Semmelweiss out of the hospital.

How many lives would have been saved throughout the years if doctors only listened to Moses in Numbers 19. He instructs the people in exile to wash in running water and change clothes after contact with a dead body. See, Semmelweiss' great "discovery" was a known truth of God all along. Find out more by studying the only real absolute truth. God's Word. (2 Timothy 2:15)
