GOD'S CO-WORKER
 1 Thessalonians 3:1-10

I recently visited a congregation where some of my family attends. The question was asked in class, "Does God need us?" The majority of the class was saying no that God does not need us. For the most part you may feel the same way. God existed before us and did just fine without us. His existence does not depend on me and I give nothing to Him that he cannot do without.

But I had to remind them of His purpose since He created us. Luke 19:10 says that He came to the earth with one mission in mind and that was seeking and saving lost people. Since man fell from grace in the Garden of Eden it has been God's goal to rejoin us to Him. To accomplish that purpose He uses humans according to Matthew 28:19-20. (That means me) Romans 10:14-17 make it plain that unless humans are preaching and teaching the Gospel to lost souls they cannot be saved. That means God needs me to accomplish His purpose with the earth. So then God needs us!

Paul calls Timothy God's fellow-worker in the Gospel of Christ in 1 Thessalonians 3:2. This means that Timothy was working together with God to spread the Gospel to a lost and dying world. He was also sharing the Gospel with a struggling congregation of the Lord's people to bolster their faith. God needed Timothy to do the work of an evangelist and teach the Gospel to other people. Who is God's Timothy today? If you answered that the preacher is I want you to reconsider. Not that the preacher should not be the Lord's fellow-worker, but each of us should work together with Christ to accomplish His purpose on earth. All Christians are called to be God's co-workers. If you do not do it, who will?
