### TOO BUSY FOR CHURCH

via Gospel Minutes - Questions and Bible Answers  
 By David Thurman

Dear brother Thurman: What would you say to someone who won't come to church because they are too busy? I know about Hebrews 10:25, but what other verses could apply?

"Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful; and let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds, not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another; and all the more, as you see the day drawing near" (Heb 10:23-25). The book of Hebrews is written to believers who are thinking of abandoning Christ and returning to be just Jews. God says several things in these three verses.

Some were (and are) in the habit of missing the assemblies of the church. The purpose of the assembly is to encourage and edify each other. A person too busy to attend is thinking only of self, not of his or her obligation to build up other believers. We are to consider each other and motivate each other to doing God's work here and now. When we are apart, we cannot accomplish any of that.

As to other verses, several come to mind. "Do not be anxious then, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'With what shall we clothe ourselves?' For all these things the Gentiles eagerly seek; for your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added to you" (Matt. 6:31-33). Notice the anxiety Jesus is talking about. These are people busy worrying about income, about food and clothing, the same things people are busy with today. God knows our needs. He knows we need to work and be productive, after all He made us that way. But, He knows we have spiritual needs that out weigh all other needs. If God is first (and He is whether we acknowledge Him or not), we should put Him first and create a new habit of attending the assemblies of the church.
