HAITI REPORT

One of the greatest lessons that can be learned is that the hardest work is often the most rewarding. So it is with those of us who recently returned from Haiti. There was literally a mountain of work to be done. We bagged over 40,000 pounds of beans and 40,000 pounds of rice. We unloaded a container brought in by semi and a large box truck full of supplies by hand. While transferring the 100 pound bags of rice and beans to 5 pound bags we also put together family packs of food to be distributed in the communities which suffered the most devastation. Preachers from those areas came and took loads of food back to their communities. We distributed nearly 3,000 sacks of food that each weighed about 15 pounds.

As a result of the work being done there in the Port-au-Prince area, the Santo church of Christ, where we worshipped, has baptized 28 people, 7 during the week we were in attendance. One man came and made public confession; he had been away from the church and found Santo deciding to restore his life to Christ.

The three of us, Jim, Becky, and I, did not do much in the grand scheme of all that has to be done, but big things are done in small steps, and we were part of the small steps. The work must go on. For decades they will still be working to repair and rebuild the city of Port-au-Prince and its surrounding communities. As that work progresses, the Lord's work is also being done. The Gospel is being spread and we must be part of that. Many have given money and goods, as we can we should keep this going. Add fervent prayer to what you offer to Haiti. Those in Haiti never had much, but what little they had has been taken away. In that void Jesus is trying to step in and in some cases He is successful. Let us pray most of all that those doors opened by this disaster are filled with the presence of Christ and many continue to find their answers in His grace and salvation.
